Music Scholarship

Auditions will be held on Friday 11 February 2022 at St Peter's College.

The Music Scholarship is for students with talent and promise within music entering in Years 7 to 11 in 2023.

The scholarship provides remission of up to 50% of tuition fees or 100% instrumental fees at the discretion of the Headmaster.

Instructions

Students applying for a Music Scholarship in Years 7 must sit the ACEP exam in February to be considered for a music audition.

The applicant details on the next page need to be completed. Please ensure this page forms the front page of your application package. Refer to the checklist to ensure you have attached all documentation the School has requested.

Your son's music scholarship application will be provided to the Director of Music at St Peter's College. The music department will be in touch to make a time for an audition. **Students must supply their own accompanist at the audition.**

Applicants applying for entry for Years 8 to 11 must pay a \$75 application fee, unless the student is a current student, accepted or waitlisted for St Peter's College. Please address your application to:

Checklist

For the student to be considered for a scholarship, please ensure all the requested documents are supplied.

If seeking a Year 7 Music Scholarship, you must have registered via the St Peter's College website for the student to sit the ACEP exam on Saturday 5 February 2022 (ACER registration closes on Thursday 20 January 2022, 11.30 pm CDT).

Evidence of AMEB Grade 3 or equivalent for the principal instrument for those applying for Year 7, or evidence of AMEB Grade 4 or equivalent for the principal instrument for those applying for Years 8 to 11.

A cover letter written by the student and a letter from the parents/guardians, detailing their reasons for seeking a Music Scholarship.

A recent photo of the student. *Not required if student already attends St Peter's College.*

A copy of the student's most recent school report. *Not required if student already attends St Peter's College.*

Copies of the student's last two NAPLAN results. (NAPLAN testing is in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9) *Not required if student already attends St Peter's College.*

A list of the student's playing and performance experience (both at school and outside school) including solo and ensemble experiences and length of involvement with each ensemble.

A short list of pieces from which the Director of Music may select for audition for the principal instrument, and where applicable, for the second instrument.

Complete the credit card payment section on the back of the form to pay the \$75 scholarship application fee (if applicable).
