Senior School Community Day

Event Guide

Community Day is a highlight on our House calendar, as it brings students, staff and families together for some competitive sport in the morning, followed by a lunch in House areas from 12.30pm.

COVID-19 requirements that remain in place:

Staff, students, and parents must not attend the campus if feeling unwell or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19

Competition Rules

The specific schedule and rules for each sport are outlined in the sections to follow. However, there are some overall expectations and rules to make the day run smoothly, and to ensure the competition is both enjoyable and fair for all parties.

1. Students can only compete in one sport for the duration of the day and into the Finals. If students compete in two sports, both teams which fielded the player will be disqualified.
2. The Junior competition is to be made up of Year 7 to 9 students, and Senior competition must be Year 10 to 12. There is an exception in Touch Rugby, where a House can use a Year 10 in the Junior competition if they are short on numbers. However, those Year 10s cannot also play in the Senior competition. If they do, both teams that used the Year 10 are disqualified.
3. Students must wear their House top to compete. Students who don't have correct House attire will not be able to take part in games.
4. Students are not permitted to wear hair bands of any sort. Players who wear them are not permitted to take the field.
5. Students need to be on time, at least 10 minutes before the scheduled start time of the game.
6. If a team is lower in numbers than the opposition, every effort can be made to start the game on time and keep it fair by reducing the number of players on the court/field for both teams. Umpires should default, whenever possible, to having a fair game begin on time. However, if Houses can't field an adequate number of players, the umpire may decide to deem the game a forfeit. The Coordinator of each Sport needs to be present to assist in any disputes.
7. Students cannot use poor language, such as swearing or using homophobic, racist or misogynistic comments. Players who infringe these rules will be sent off and can't be replaced on the court/field.
8. Any overall disputes about the conduct of the day are to be taken to Barnaby Eaton.

Table Tennis Draw

All Junior and Senior Table Tennis matches will be held in the Western end of the Green Shed. Teams must report to the Green Shed by 9.40am and be ready for a briefing at 9.45am. Scoring and rules will be explained at the briefing. House shirts and sports shoes must be worn by all team members.

- Each House may enter one Junior and one Senior team
- Teams must be minimum of 4 players, maximum of 10
- Teams are allowed to cycle through players at their own wish for each round
- Matches will begin at 10.00am promptly

Breakdown:

- There will be 9 rounds (matches) across the morning
- Each team will play 2 doubles matches at the same time for each round
- Matches will be 5 minutes in length
- Once the siren sounds to indicate the start of play, matches are to be played continuously for the full 5 minutes
- Teams are to aim for the highest score possible within the time limit
- At the end of the time, scores will be recorded for both teams
- Boys must score themselves throughout the morning
- The top 4 teams based on the most points accrued across all 9 rounds in each division will enter a semifinal 1vs2 and 3vs4
- The top 2 teams in junior and senior divisions of the semifinals will play off in a final match to determine the overall winner in each division
- If teams are still drawn, the top 2 teams will play off in a final 5min match

Gear:

Table Tennis boys are encouraged to bring their own bats & cleaning equipment. For boys not playing Table Tennis as a winter sport, a limited number of bats will be provided on the day. Balls will be supplied for matches only. Sport shoes must be worn by all players.

Soccer Draw

- All Games are 15 minutes long
- 7-a-side (including goalkeeper)
- There is no offside rule in the game.
- Other standard soccer rules apply.
- The decision by the referee is final.
- All players MUST wear shin-pads.
- Studded boots are strongly recommended.
- House colours are to be worn.
- There will not be a half time and games will run for 15 minutes in total.
- The running table will be administered next to the Drama Centre on the Lloyd Oval.
- The winning captain (or both drawing captains together) must get a score sheet filled in by the referee and return it to the Mr Inman at the running table. The supervising teacher will have the score sheets to distribute.
- Lloyd West 1 and Lloyd East 1 pitches are closest to the changing rooms. The Lloyd number 2 pitches are furthest from the changing rooms.
- All students must be ready to go, at their pitch, at least 5 minutes before kick-off, as turnaround time will be only 5 minutes.
- When all junior games are finished, all boys are encouraged to watch their senior House in their final game.
- ONE SPORT AND ONE AGE GROUP ONLY rules apply. (Game points forfeited for transgressors – 2 – 0 win awarded to other team).

Points

- Win = 3 points
- Draw = 1 point
- Loss = 0 points
- Goals For / Against
- Winning team is based on points tallied. If equal, it will be based on goal difference, then goals for, then the result of the game played between equal sides.
- If all else is equal, a play off or penalty shootout between the two sides will result.

Basketball Rules

- All games played indoors in Sports Centre and Junior School Hall
- 5 v 5 full court
- **Minor round games** = 12-minutes (2 x 6 min halves with 1-minute half-time break). Foul count limit = 4 fouls per player.
- **Grand final** = 20-minutes (2 x 10 min halves with 1-minute half-time break). Clock stops on whistles in the last minute of 2nd half. Foul count limit = 5 fouls per player.
- Bonus free throws after the 5th team foul.
- All other standard playing rules apply (umpires to manage)
- At the end of all minor-round games, the top 2 teams from each pool will cross-over to play in the semi-final. The winners of each semi-final will then play off in the grand-final.
- These rules apply for both the Junior and Senior basketball competition.

Additional Information

- Teams must arrive at least 5 mins prior to their scheduled game tip-off.
- All players must be wearing their respective House top.
- Players and spectators should demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times.
- All scoresheets must be returned to Ms. Heim in the Sports Centre at the conclusion of each game with FINAL SCORE & WINNER clearly indicated.

Please NOTE: Teams must send a representative to the Sports Centre at the end of all minor rounds to see if they have made it through to the semi-finals.

Touch Rugby Draw

Teams

- No more than 6 players on the field at a time (a team requires a minimum of 7 members and a maximum of 9 members)
- Game duration is two 7-minute halves with a 2-minute half-time break. There will be a 4-minute break between games.
- Each House team will play 4 others Houses.
- Each House team will require to supply a student referee to assist the staff referees. Senior student referees will referee junior games and junior student referees will referee senior games.
- All team will be expected to be present at the rugby shed (Farr Oval) no later than 8.15am.

Rules

- 6 players per team on the pitch at any one time.
- A one-handed touch is an effective touch, play starts from where player was touched.
- Defensive team must be 5 meters back from the position where player was touched.
- A dropped ball, knock-on, forward pass, or completion of 6 touches will cause a change in possession.
- Offside play, or other inappropriate play will incur a penalty (loss of 10m and possession).

BASIC RULES

- played on half sized ovals
- **Junior Games: 2 x 8 minutes halves with 4 minute breaks at half time**
- **Senior Games: 2 x 9 minutes halves with 4 minute breaks at half time**
- Game begins with a kick from the centre half back position by the team that won the toss (Paper, rock scissors)
- the second half begins with a kick from the centre half back position by the team that lost the toss at the start of the game
- after a goal is scored the team scored against takes a kick from the centre half back position
- 30m kick maximum
- only one bounce per player
- no ruck contests
- only the 3 designated forwards (distinguishable) can score
- Last touch over the boundary line: Free kick goes to the opposition
- **houses supply a goal umpire**
- no runners allowed on the ground
- no swearing, unduly rough play or arguing with the umpire will be accepted
Penalty: Shot on goal 25m out in front
Second offence the player will be sent off and not replaced
