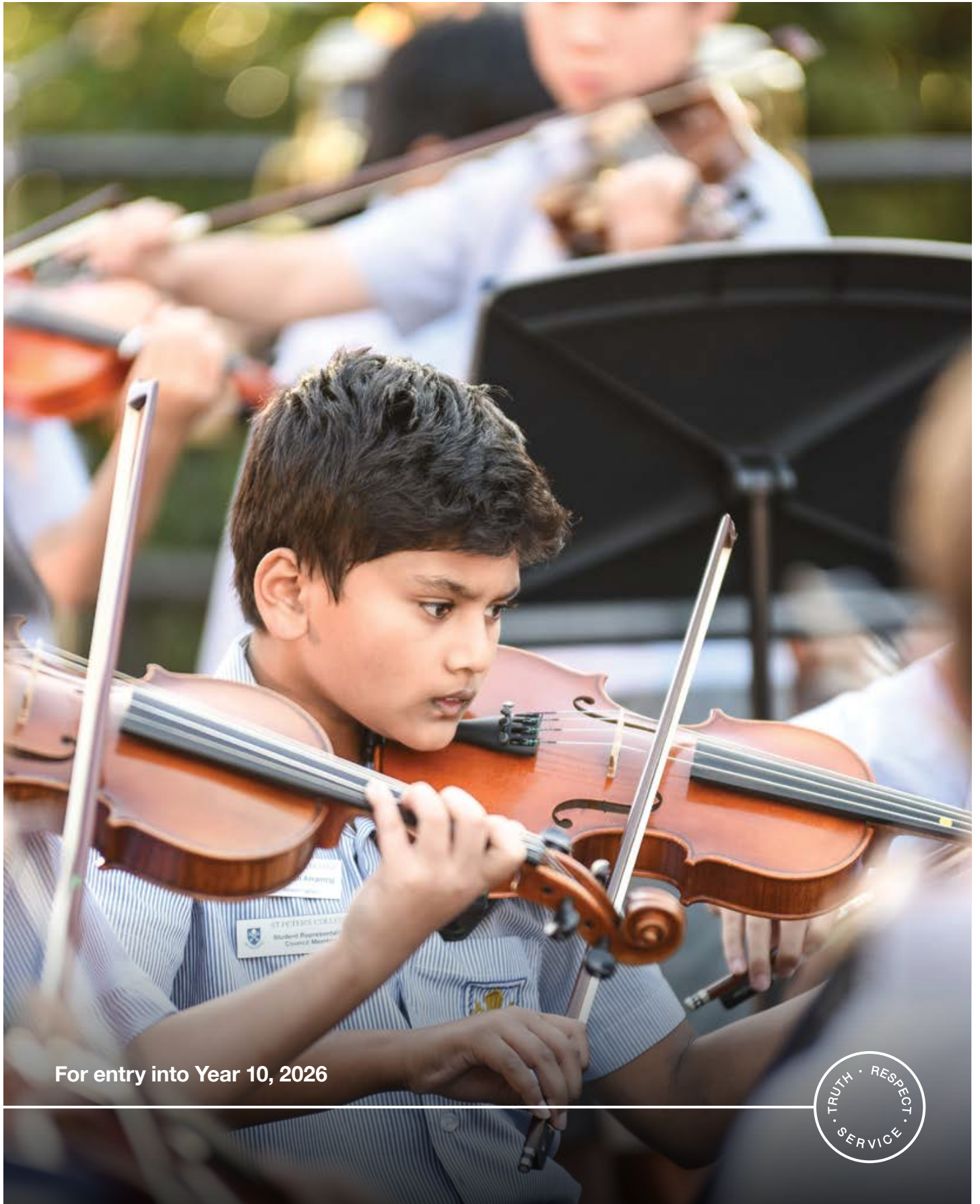

# Wyandra Music Scholarship



For entry into Year 10, 2026



## Wyandra Music Scholarship

The Wyandra Music Scholarship has been made possible through the philanthropic support of the Wyandra Fund. This support will provide a student access to the exceptional academic, co-curricular and service learning opportunities on offer at St Peter's College.

The Wyandra Music Scholarship offers up to 50% remission of tuition, fixed charges, IT levy, 100% tuition of one classical instrument and voice lessons for a student not currently enrolled at the School and commencing in Year 10, 2026 and is applicable for up to 3 years .

### Selection Criteria

The Wyandra Music Scholarship will be awarded to a student not currently enrolled at the School and who possesses all-round qualities and can provide evidence of the following:

- Record of strong academic endeavour
- High level of participation in co-curricular activities in particular music.
- Evidence of service and/or citizenship in current school community and beyond
- High level of engagement at the current school.

This scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding student who would be unable to attend St Peter's College without financial support.

### Benefits

The Wyandra Music Scholarship for students with talent and promise within music entering in Year 10 in 2026.

The scholarship provides remission of up to 50% of tuition fees, 100% tuition of one classical instrument and voice lessons and 100% application fee.

Families will be expected to pay all other costs including:

- Enrolment fee (\$1,800)
- Transport to and from school
- Recess and lunch
- School uniform (typically initial costs of approx. \$1,500)
- Books and stationery (approx \$500 per annum)
- MacBook, required by all students (up to \$2,500)
- Additional music tuition and hire of instrument (up to \$1,250 per annum)

### Expectations

The family will be expected to participate in the School community, attending School activities and events (particularly in relation to their son's activities) and in School community groups.

Each scholarship recipient's family is encouraged to make a financial contribution to the Foundation, for the duration of the scholarship and beyond. Such support will assist the Foundation to provide similar opportunities for other students in the future.

Each recipient will be expected to provide feedback to the Foundation about the impact of the scholarship on a regular basis during his schooling and, from time to time, as an old scholar. The family will be invited to participate in occasional events and activities that recognise and give thanks to the community of donors.

## Checklist

For the student to be considered for a scholarship, please ensure all the requested documents are supplied.

A covering letter written by the student, addressing the selection criteria and detailing his reasons for seeking the Wyandra Music Scholarship.

A covering letter from the student's parents/guardians, detailing their reasons for seeking the Wyandra Music Scholarship.

A recent photo of the student.

A copy of the student's most recent school report.

A copy of NAPLAN results from Year 7.

At least one letter of reference with a daytime telephone contact commenting on the student's personal attributes and character (ideally provided by a teacher or someone who is unrelated to the student and has known the student for many years).

A copy of Australian Taxation Office (ATO) business and personal statements for the past three financial years. Information must include declarations on income, expenses, financial assets and liabilities as well as benefits or assistance received.

A separate sheet identifying areas of strength and excellence and listing the student's interests and involvement in sport, music, church, community and other activities.

Copies of any awards or certificates the student has received for academic, sporting, music, artistic, community or character achievements.

Please confirm you meet the prerequisites for consideration for this scholarship opportunity:

The applicant is an Australian Citizen and/or Permanent Resident and is currently attending a school other than St Peter's College.

The student will be in Year 10 in 2026 and be a day student (non-boarder).

We understand this scholarship is subject to means-testing and the relevant documents have been provided.

We understand the scholarship will cover 50% of tuition fees and will cover tuition for one classical instrument and voice lessons.

We also understand that if we accept the scholarship, we will endeavour to make a financial contribution to the Foundation at least once during our son's time at the School (being three years).
