Doc Ross Boarding Scholarship

The Doc Ross Boarding Scholarship is for a boarding student entering Years 8 to 10 in 2027 and provides remission of 100% of boarding fees only.

The Doc Ross Boarding Scholarship is provided by the Doc Ross Family Foundation. Patrick David (Doc) Ross was a boarder at St Peter's College (Wyatt & Allen, 1959), who later went on to found Lower Coporation, dealing in complex non ferrous minerals, metals, ores and concentrates. The Foundation is passionate about providing an education opportunity for a boarder, someone who without a scholarship would not be able to attend St Peter's College and as such, the scholarship is means tested.

Selection Criteria

The Doc Ross Boarding Scholarship will be awarded to a student who possesses all-round qualities and can provide evidence of the following:

- Record of strong academic endeavours
- Evidence of service and/or citizenship in current school community and beyond
- High level of participation in co-curricular activities (music, sport, drama, visual arts etc)
- High level of engagement at current school.

The scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding student who would be unable to attend St Peter's College without financial support. As such, this scholarship will be means tested and special consideration will also be given to social diversity.

Benefits

The Doc Ross Boarding Scholarship includes:

- Remission of 100% Boarding fees
- Application fee of \$100 and enrolment fee of \$2,600 (normally payable once a formal offer of admission to St Peter's College has been made and accepted by completing the acceptance of offer).

Families will be expected to pay all other costs including:

- Tuition fees, IT levy and fixed charges are applicable
- School uniform (typically initial costs of approx. \$1,500)
- Books and stationery (approx. \$500 per annum)
- MacBook, required by all students (up to \$2,500)
- Optional music tuition and hire of instrument (up to \$1,250 per annum).

Expectations

The family will be expected to participate in the School community, attending School activities and events (particularly in relation to their son's activities) and in School community groups.

The scholarship recipient's family is encouraged to make a financial contribution to the Foundation, for the duration of the scholarship and beyond. Such support will assist the Foundation to provide similar opportunities for other students in the future.

The recipient will be expected to provide feedback to the Foundation about the impact of the scholarship on a regular basis during his schooling and, from time to time, as an old scholar. The family will be invited to participate in occasional events and activities that recognise and give thanks to the community of donors.

A covering letter written by the student, addressing the selection criteria and detailing his reasons for seeking the Doc Ross Boarding Scholarship. ☐

A recent photo of the student. ☐

A copy of the student's most recent school report. ☐

A copy of the latest NAPLAN result. ☐

At least one letter of reference with a daytime telephone contact commenting on the student's personal attributes and character (ideally provided by a teacher or someone who is unrelated to the student and has known the student for many years). ☐

A copy of Australian Taxation Office (ATO) business and personal statements for the past three financial years. Information must include declarations on income, expenses, financial assets and liabilities as well as benefits or assistance received. ☐
